South Dakota Wheat Yield Contest Rules and Regulations 2016

Control Plot Qualifications

- The contest will be divided into seven Districts. A one-year membership (1998) can be included with every entry.
- The first entry in each additional district will be \$10 per entry. A one-year membership can cover that one entry but each entry thereafter has a different identifying name or letters.

Control Field and Entry Qualifications

- The contest will be divided into seven Districts. (map attached) The location of the field, NEFF the contest address, will determine the region of the entry. Each District will be the contest for that District. Districts include:

Superior Eligibility Qualifications

- The superior's name must be on the SDWY contest entry form along with their name, address, telephone and email address before the entry can be accepted. The superior's responsibility is to ensure the harvest and make the final competition of yield based on an accurate weight, moisture and subsided area. It is the responsibility of the contest to submit the final paperwork.
