World Agricultural Supply and Demand Estimates

As of October 11, 2018

- The outlook for 2018/19 U.S. wheat this month is larger supplies, reduced domestic use, unchanged exports and higher ending stocks.
- Global 2018/19 wheat supplies are reduced, primarily on lower production forecasts for Australia and Russia.
- Global ending stocks are reduced 1.1 million tons to 260.2 million, down 5 percent from last year's record.

South Dakota Wheat Stocks

As of September 28, 2018

- Total stocks: 87,500,000 bushels (+22.0% from 2018)
- On-farm stocks: 40,500,000 bushels (+45.0% from 2018)
- Off-farm stocks: 47,000,000 bushels (+8.0% from 2018)

2018 South Dakota Winter Wheat

As of September 28, 2018

- 830,000 acres planted in fall 2017 (-9.0% from fall 2016)
- 660,000 acres harvested (+27% from 2017)
- 80% of planted acres
- 31.7 million bushels (+52% from 2017)
- 48.0 bushels/acre (+8 bpa from 2017)

2018 South Dakota Spring Wheat

As of September 28, 2018

- 1,050,000 acres planted (+8% from 2017)
- 965,000 acres harvested (+44% from 2017)
- 92% of planted acres
- 40.5 million bushels (+95% in 2017)
- 42.0 bushels /acre (+11 bpa in 2017)

- #6 All Wheat: 2,203,785 acres (2017)
- #8 Winter Wheat: 1,208,309 acres (2017)
