## ★ World Agricultural Supply and Demand Estimates

As of March 8, 2019

- The outlook for 2018/19 U.S. wheat this month is for larger supplies, lower exports, reduced domestic use, and higher ending stocks.
- Supplies are increased by 5 million bushels on higher imports.
- Wheat exports are lowered 35 million bushels to 965 million with reductions in Hard Red Spring and White on stronger than expected competition for these classes.
- Global ending stocks are increased 3.0 million tons to 275.0 million, down 3% from last year's record.

## ★ South Dakota Wheat Stocks

As of March 29, 2019

- Total stocks: 57,200,000 bushels (+15.0% from 2018)
- On-farm stocks: 24,500,000 bushels (+44.0% from 2018)
- Off-farm stocks: 32,700,000 bushels (- from 2018)

## ★ 2019 South Dakota Winter Wheat

As of March 29, 2019

- 850,000 acres planted in fall 2018 (+2% from fall 2017)

## 2018 South Dakota Winter Wheat

As of September 28, 2018

- 660,000 acres harvested (+27% from 2017)
- 80% of planted acres (830,000 acres)
- 31.7 million bushels (+52% from 2017)
- 48.0 bushels/acre (+8 bpa from 2017)

## ★ 2019 South Dakota Spring Wheat

As of March 29, 2019

- 1,020,000 acres intended to be planted (-3.0% from 2018)

## 2018 South Dakota Spring Wheat

As of September 28, 2018

- 1,050,000 acres planted (+8% from 2017)
- 965,000 acres harvested (+44% from 2017)
- 92% of planted acres
- 40.5 million bushels (+95% in 2017)
- 42.0 bushels /acre (+11 bpa in 2017)

- #8 Winter Wheat: 1,208,309 acres (2017)
