World Agricultural Supply and Demand Estimates

As of May 10, 2019

- **The initial outlook for 2019/20 U.S. wheat is for larger supplies, higher domestic use, lower exports and larger stocks.**
- Supplies are increased by 41 million bushels year to year with higher carry-in stocks and larger production.
- Ending stocks for 2019/20 are projected 14 million bushels higher than last year at 1,141 million.
- **The initial outlook for 2019/20 international wheat is for larger supplies, increased trade, greater consumption and higher ending stocks.**
- World stocks less China are projected at 146.8 million tons, up 11.8 million from last year.

South Dakota Wheat Stocks

As of March 29, 2019

- Total stocks: 57,200,000 bushels (+15.0% from 2018)
- On-farm stocks: 24,500,000 bushels (+44.0% from 2018)
- Off-farm stocks: 32,700,000 bushels (- from 2018)

2019 South Dakota Winter Wheat

As of May 1, 2019

- 720,000 acres harvested forecast (+60K acres from 2018)
- 83% of planted acres harvest forecast (+3% from 2018)
- 38.9 million bushels forecast (+23% from 2018)
- 54 bushels/acre forecast (+ 6 bpa from 2018)

2018 South Dakota Winter Wheat

As of September 28, 2018

- 660,000 acres harvested (+27% from 2017)
- 80% of planted acres (830,000 acres)
- 31.7 million bushels (+52% from 2017)
- 48.0 bushels/acre (+8 bpa from 2017)

2019 South Dakota Spring Wheat

As of March 29, 2019

- 1,020,000 acres intended to be planted (-3.0% from 2018)

2018 South Dakota Spring Wheat

As of September 28, 2018

- 1,050,000 acres planted (+8% from 2017)
- 965,000 acres harvested (+44% from 2017)
- 92% of planted acres
- 40.5 million bushels (+95% in 2017)
- 42.0 bushels /acre (+11 bpa in 2017)
