★ World Agricultural Supply and Demand Estimates

As of February 11, 2020

- The outlook for 2019/20 U.S. wheat is for stable supplies, increased exports, and decreased ending stocks.
- Global wheat supplies are lowered fractionally on small and mostly offsetting changes to beginning stocks and production.
- For the 2019/20 market year, global consumption and ending stocks are lowered fractionally though the **world ending stocks remain record large.**

South Dakota Wheat Stocks

As of January 10, 2020

- Total stocks: 61.7 million bushels (-10% from 2019)
- On-farm stocks: 23.5 million bushels (-16% from 2019)
- Off-farm stocks: 38.2 million bushels (-5% from 2019)

2020 South Dakota Winter Wheat

As of January 10, 2020

- 700,000 acres planted (-19% from 2019)

2019 South Dakota Winter Wheat

As of September 30, 2019

- 860,000 acres planted (+4% from 2018)
- 770,000 acres harvested forecast (+17% from 2018)
- 90% of planted acres harvested forecast
- 40.0 million bushels forecast (+26% from 2018)
- 52 bushels/acre forecast (+ 4 bpa from 2018)

2019 South Dakota Spring Wheat

As of November 8, 2019

- 640,000 acres planted (-39% from 2018) **RECORD LOW**
- 605,000 acres harvested forecast (-37% from 2018)
- 95% of planted acres harvested forecast
- 26.0 million bushels forecast (-36% from 2018)
- 43 bushels/acre forecast (+ 1 bpa from 2018)
