## **★** World Agricultural Supply and Demand Estimates

As of November 10, 2020

- The outlook for 2020/21 U.S. wheat this month is for stable supplies, higher domestic use, unchanged exports, and reduced ending stocks.
- The 2020/21 global wheat outlook is for larger supplies, increased consumption, higher exports, and reduced stocks.
- Projected 2020/21 world ending stocks are lowered 1.0 million tons to 320.5 million but remain RECORD HIGH.

#### **South Dakota Wheat Stocks**

As of September 30, 2020

• Total stocks: 85.8 million bushels (+4% from 2019)

• On-farm stocks: 42.0 million bushels (-2% from 2019)

Off-farm stocks: 43.8 million bushels (+11% from 2019)

#### 2020 South Dakota Winter Wheat

As of September 30, 2020

- 630,000 acres est. planted (-27% from 2019)
- 600,000 acres est. harvested (-22% from 2019)
- 95% of planted acres harvested
- 34.8 million bushels est. harvested (-13% from 2019)
- 58 bushels per acre est. (+6 from 2019) RECORD TIE

#### 2020 South Dakota Spring Wheat

As of September 30, 2020

- 770,000 acres est. planted (+20% from 2019)
- 760,000 acres est. harvested (+29% from 2019)
- 99% of planted acres harvested
- 35.7 million bushels est. harvested (+41% from 2019)
- 47 bushels/acre est. (+4 bpa from 2019)
