★ World Agricultural Supply and Demand Estimates

As of July 12, 2021

- The outlook for 2021/22 U.S. wheat this month is for reduced supplies, lower domestic use and exports, and decreased ending stocks.
- The global wheat outlook for 2021/22 is for reduced supplies, fractionally lower consumption, increased trade, and lower ending stocks.
- Projected 2021/22 world ending stocks are lowered 5.1 million tons to 291.7 million but remain above last year.

★ South Dakota Wheat Stocks

As of June 30, 2021

- Total stocks: 36.4 million bushels (-20% from 2020)
- On-farm stocks: 13.0 million bushels (-28% from 2020)
- Off-farm stocks: 23.4 million bushels (-16% from 2020)

★ 2021 South Dakota Winter Wheat

As of July 12, 2021

- 780,000 acres est. planted (+24% from 2020)
- 680,000 acres est. harvested (+13% from 2020)
- 87% of planted acres harvested (-8% from 2020)
- 29.9 million bushels est. harvested (-14% from 2020)
- 44 bushels per acre est. (-14 from 2020)

★ 2021 South Dakota Spring Wheat

As of July 12, 2021

- 730,000 acres est. planted (-5% from 2020)
- 700,000 acres est. harvested (-8% from 2020)
- 96% of planted acres harvested (-3% from 2020)
- 17.5 million bushels est. harvested (-51% from 2020)
- 25 bushels/acre est. (-22 bpa from 2020)
