★ World Agricultural Supply and Demand Estimates

As of May 12, 2022

- The outlook for 2022/23 U.S. wheat is for reduced supplies, exports, domestic use stocks, and higher prices.
- The global outlook for 2022/23 is for lower supplies and consumption, increased trade and lower ending stocks.
- Projected 2022/23 global trade is a record 204.9 million tons, up 5.0 million from last year.
- Projected 2022/23 world ending stocks are reduced 5 percent to 267.0 million tons and would be the lowest level in six years.

South Dakota Wheat Stocks

As of March 31, 2022

- Total stocks: 9.5 million bushels (-58% from 2021)
- On-farm stocks: 22.8 million bushels (-33% from 2021)
- Off-farm stocks: 32.3 million bushels (-43% from 2021)

2022 South Dakota Winter Wheat

As of January 12, 2022

- 830,000 acres est. planted (+3.8% from 2021)

2021 South Dakota Winter Wheat

As of September 30, 2021

- 800,000 acres est. planted (+27% from 2020)
- 720,000 acres est. harvested (+20% from 2020)
- 90% of planted acres harvested (+3% from 2020)
- 27.4 million bushels est. harvested (-21% from 2020)
- 38 bushels per acre est. (-20 from 2020)

2022 South Dakota Spring Wheat

As of March 31, 2022

- 730,000 acres est. planted (+1.4% from 2021)

2021 South Dakota Spring Wheat

As of September 30, 2021

- 720,000 acres est. planted (-6% from 2020)
- 590,000 acres est. harvested (-22% from 2020)
- 82% of planted acres harvested (-14% from 2020)
- 17.1 million bushels est. harvested (-52% from 2020)
- 29 bushels/acre est. (-18 bpa from 2020)
