★ World Agricultural Supply and Demand Estimates

As of June 10, 2022

- The outlook for 2022/23 U.S. wheat this month is for increased supplies, unchanged domestic use and exports, and higher stocks .
- The global outlook for 2022/23 is for lower supplies, reduced consumption, fractionally lower trade and slightly lower ending stocks.
- Projected 2022/23 global trade is decreased 0.3 million tons to 204.6 million.
- Projected 2022/23 world ending stocks are lowered 0.2 million tons to 266.9 million, a six-year low.

South Dakota Wheat Stocks

As of March 31, 2022

- Total stocks: 9.5 million bushels (-58% from 2021)
- On-farm stocks: 22.8 million bushels (-33% from 2021)
- Off-farm stocks: 32.3 million bushels (-43% from 2021)

★ 2022 South Dakota Winter Wheat

As of June 10, 2022

- 830,000 acres est. planted (+3.8% from 2021)
- 720,000 acres est. harvested (unchanged from 2021)
- 87% of planted acres est. harvested (-3% from 2021)
- 33.8 million bushels est. harvested (+24% from 2021)
- 47 bushels per acre est. (+9 from 2021)

2021 South Dakota Winter Wheat

As of September 30, 2021

- 800,000 acres planted (+27% from 2020)
- 720,000 acres harvested (+20% from 2020)
- 90% of planted acres harvested (+3% from 2020)
- 27.4 million bushels harvested (-21% from 2020)
- 38 bushels per acre (-20 from 2020)

2022 South Dakota Spring Wheat

As of March 31, 2022

- 730,000 acres est. planted (+1.4% from 2021)

2021 South Dakota Spring Wheat

As of September 30, 2021

- 720,000 acres planted (-6% from 2020)
- 590,000 acres harvested (-22% from 2020)
- 82% of planted acres harvested (-14% from 2020)
- 17.1 million bushels harvested (-52% from 2020)
- 29 bushels/acre (-18 bpa from 2020)
