World Agricultural Supply and Demand Estimates

As of September 12, 2022

- The 2022/23 U.S. wheat outlook for supply and use is unchanged this month.
- The 2022/23 global wheat outlook raises supplies, consumption, exports, and ending stocks this month.
- World ending stocks increase 1.2 million tons to 268.6 million as stock increases in Russia and Ukraine more than offset a decline in the EU.

South Dakota Wheat Stocks

As of June 30, 2022

• Total stocks: 23.8 million bushels (-35% from 2021)

• On-farm stocks: 6.8 million bushels (-48% from 2021)

• Off-farm stocks: 17.0 million bushels (-27% from 2021)

2022 South Dakota Winter Wheat

As of July 12, 2022

- 830,000 acres est. planted (+4% from 2021)
- 760,000 acres est. harvested (+6% from 2021)
- 91.6% of planted acres est. harvested
- 39.5 million bushels est. harvested (+44% from 2021)
- 52 bushels per acre est. (+14 from 2021)

2022 South Dakota Spring Wheat

As of July 12, 2022

- 770,000 acres est. planted (+7% from 2021)
- 730,000 acres est. harvested (+24% from 2021)
- 94.8% of planted acres est. harvested
- 32.1 million bushels est. harvested (+88% from 2021)
- 44 bushels per acre est. (+15 from 2021)
